IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the (attorneys for) defendant(s) and the attorneys for plaintiff as follow:

1. Defendant(s) appear in this action and consent to the jurisdiction of the court.

2. Defendant(s) agree to pay plaintiff the sum of \$1,677.00 as follows:

- a. \$1,400.00 on March 28, 2011;
- b. \$ 138.50 on April 28, 2011;
- c. \$ 138.50 on May 28, 2011.

3. All payments shall be made to the order of RUBIN & ROTHMAN, as attorneys, 1787 Veterans Highway, P.O. Box 550, Islandia, New York 11749 and refer to file No. 87015.

4. Judgment entered on January 12, 2011 in the amount of \$3,310.38 shall stand as security. Plaintiff agrees to withhold the enforcement of judgment as long as payments are made in accordance with the terms of this stipulation. In the event defendant(s) fail to make the payments due hereunder for ten (10) days after the due date, plaintiff may proceed with the enforcement of judgment for the full amount claimed in the complaint, together with interest, costs, disbursements, crediting defendants(s) with any payments made hereunder. Defendant(s) hereby discontinue with prejudice any counterclaims that they may have against plaintiff.

5. Upon payment by defendant(s) in accordance with the terms of this stipulation, plaintiff will issue a stipulation discontinuing action or send a letter to the court notifying it that the case is settled. Defendant(s) authorize the plaintiff's attorneys to communicate with them and waive any previous cease or desist request.

6. Facsimile copies of this fully executed Stipulation shall have the same legal effect as the original.
